FURTHER INFORMATION

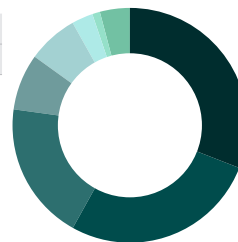
- The fund has no bias to any industry, economic sector, country or region. It will invest in regulated markets globally, which may include exposure to emerging markets.
